	What work will pupils be expected to complete?	How will they receive feedback?
Y11 & 13 (also 12 if sitting AS)	 Pupils will be told to complete any outstanding NEA/coursework as far as is practical For pupils in Y11 there will be transition work available within the next few weeks for any courses they are intending to take at Backwell Sixth Form Pupils also have access to their Unifrog account for continued careers and next steps preparation Please note that pupils will not need to complete any more of their revision programme 	NEAs/coursework to be assessed as usual
Years 10 & 12	 All work will be set on Frog Each subject will set work which enables, as far as possible, pupils to continue to work through the curriculum Each subject will also set one substantial piece of work per week which is to be submitted to their class teacher. It is most likely that this would be an exam question/s As a guide this should take around an hour to complete Pupils will receive instructions on how to submit this and it is likely to be via Frog or email 	 Pupils will receive feedback on the weekly piece of work they submit This could be in a number of ways: Individual feedback Whole class feedback A recorded message If they have completed an exam question then they will also receive a mark
Years 7, 8 & 9	 Maths, English and Science All work will be set on Frog For each subject pupils will be set a substantial piece of work per week which is to be submitted to the class teacher This should take between 30-45 minutes to complete 	 Any work which pupils submit will be acknowledgement and if appropriate feedback given This could be in a number of ways: Individual feedback

MFL, Humanities, Art and Design

- All work will be set on Frog
- Each subject will set one substantial piece of work per fortnight
- This should take between 30-45 minutes to complete
- In addition each subject will also set a variety of tasks or an open ended project
- Pupils will receive instructions as to how they submit work which is most likely to be through Frog or email

Performing arts

- All work will be set on Frog
- One substantial piece of work with additional variety of tasks or open ended project
- In addition pupils will also be set a variety of tasks or an open ended project
- Pupils will receive instructions as to how they submit this which is most likely to be through Frog or email

- Whole class feedback
- A recorded message
- If they have completed an assessment then they would also receive a mark
